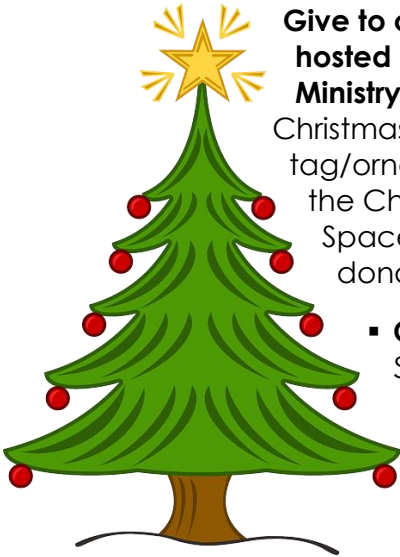
contributions via Debt Reduction envelopes, along with our


